



On Wednesday, April 30, 2008, the monthly MARCAN meeting was called to order by President Susan Smith at 1146 hours. There were thirteen members present at this meeting, held at Olathe Police Department. No minutes were read because Secretary Beverly Redding was not present last month and failed to arrange for someone else to take the notes.

Treasurer's Report

Carol Stanton presented a report which listed the beginning April balance at \$2,800.80. We had credits of \$93.63, debits of \$1,748.19, (\$1,305.00 of which had already been subtracted), leaving an ending balance of \$2,466.24.

Membership Report

We have several renewals, and one new member, a sergeant with KCMO PD. Kendra announced that she is resigning her position as Vice President in Charge of Membership, and Dawne Jarrett was appointed by Susan and ratified by the Board to assume those duties, effective June 1.

Training Report

Dawn Clausius reported that 52 people are signed up for May 2nd's First Fridays Training, featuring Chief Tom Casady, Lincoln PD. Back Yard Burgers is furnishing lunch.

The Fundamentals of Analysis course that Susan taught for IACA had a record number of attendees, 19 in all. As the host agency, Overland Park received two (2) free spots. MARCAN, for collaborating with the IACA to put on the training, received one half of the total profit. MARCAN's share was \$1,468.41.

Between July 21 and 25, the IACA's Tactical Analysis Class will be taught by Sally Ainsworth, at OPPD's Antioch Station. Twelve students will be necessary in order to hold the class. Currently, no one is enrolled in the training.

Ideas for presenters at the MARCAN conference should be referred to Dawn.

Old Business

The scholarship requirements and application for the IACA Conference were approved and will be added to the web site by Tim Layman. The award will be given in August for the October conference. Dawne Jarrett requested that she be removed from the Scholarship Committee so that she can apply. Mike Fracul was appointed to the committee and will join Carol Stanton and Jen Dachenhausen in serving as the selection committee for the award.

New Business

Jamie May brought an umbrella to show an example of what she's ordered. The umbrellas will be sold for \$20 each. The logo was approved to be changed on the coasters and the web site added. We are ordering \$300 worth of coasters. Jamie also presented two card holders for approval, and it was decided to order 150 of the more expensive one.

The meeting was adjourned at 1241 hours.
