Treasurer's Report

Training Report

Twelve people, the requisite number, are registered for the Tactical Analysis class, to be held at Overland Park. We held a drawing for a tuition scholarship worth \$350 for that class, and Carol Stanton won the drawing.

Michelle Kennedy will administer the IACA certification test at our conference. The cost is \$150, and the packets must be submitted by July 20 for approval. The test takes about four hours.

Old Business

New Business

Several designs have been suggested for the new MARCAN logo. They will be sent out in a group email, and members will be asked to vote for their top three. The design will then be selected based on the highest number of votes.

Susan will teach a two day Criminal Statistics class; the first order of business is to find an available computer lab. Bev Redding is calling the county ITS unit to ascertain if theirs is free at some time this year.

Congratulations to Susan, who announced that she has taken a position with the NIJ as their new program director, a year to year position.
