



On April 28, 2010, the monthly MARCAN meeting was called to order at 1135 hours by President Dawn Clausius, with fourteen people present. The meeting was held at the Sylvester Powell Community Center in Mission.

The minutes were read and approved with two corrections. The suggested training topic is called DDACTS. Lisa McMullen was not on the IACA Conference Scholarship Committee.

Treasurer's Report

In the absence of Carol Stanton, Bev Redding read the Treasurer's Report, which Carol had prepared. The beginning balance in April was \$4,260.93. Credits totaled \$175.99, and debits totaled \$1,503.52, leaving an ending balance of \$2,933.40.

Membership Report

Kyle Stoker advised that he had mailed a check for \$1,455.00 to IACA for 97 MARCAN members.

Training Report/Old Business

Jen Dachenhausen reported the IACA Problem Analysis class scheduled for May 10th through the 14th at Independence PD has been cancelled.

She also advised that retired FBI agent Jeff Lanza does a four hour presentation on human trafficking with a trafficking survivor who lives in Canada. In order to have her present with him, we would be responsible for her travel and lodging, approximately \$1,500. Jen is going to ask him if he'll do a solo presentation on June 4th, and Jamie will see if the firehouse venue is available that day.

Jen is also going to find out if we could schedule a four hour presentation of "Beyond the Cuffs" for the second half of the day, if Lanza will take the first half.

Regarding the proposed DDACTS training, Susan said that because Shawnee is implementing their recommended traffic enforcement strategies, DDACTS representatives will be at their station part of the week of June 7, and therefore, Shawnee will host that class. Members from all area agencies are invited to attend a free presentation on the afternoon of Wednesday, June 9, from 1 to 4 pm.

There is no update from the By-Laws Committee.

An email will soon be sent out by a member of the scholarship committee detailing application information for those planning to apply for the scholarship for the 2010 IACA/POP Conference.

New Business

MARCAN is planning to host ATAC Group User Sessions led by Jim Anderson, Crime Analysis Unit Supervisor for Topeka PD. Dates are still tentative. Attendees would bring their own laptops loaded with the ATAC software, and Jim would facilitate the sessions, which would be free and open to MARCAN members.

The meeting was adjourned at 1214 hours.
