Treasurer's Report

Carol reported that the beginning balance in September was \$1,012.20. Debits totaled \$1,688.86 and credits were \$3,395.22, leaving an ending balance of \$2,718.56. Carol noted that so far, we have cleared \$2,407.51 from the conference.

Training Report

Dawn has asked to be informed of the actual total number of attendees for the Bellmio FFFT as well as the Conference.

In the morning, Captain John Cato, Independence PD, will discuss "Fixing Broken Windows," which is a hot topic these days. In the afternoon, Kansas City, MO, Police Officer Corey Carlisle will present "Beyond the Cuffs," which was developed as a filter to combine multiple community services programs into one central location. We will charge \$20 for non-members, which will include lunch.

Old Business

Dawn commented that there are approximately 700 registrants for the IACA/POP Conference. Those who attend are asked to network and bring back ideas for future training sessions and instructor contacts.

New Business

Jen offered to share the new Independence PD redistricting project with anyone who wants a copy.

Next year members will alternate taking doughnuts to the meetings at UMKC, and those who participate will pay for the items themselves, then will immediately be reimbursed by MARCAN at the meeting, with a receipt if desired. UMKC will furnish the coffee.

The meeting was adjourned at 1211 hours.
