## **Crime Control and Police Staffing in Hard Economic Times**

This session will describe data analysis and community based crime control planning work that will need to be done when financial problems force hard choices on state and local governments. Examples of measures of police workload will be provided as well as insight into data quality problems. Then the Community Crime Control Planning process will be explained. It is a grass roots, data driven process through which the community and government leaders can work together to address key crime control goals that will make a community safer. Finally, a story board exercise will be conducted in which participants can identify critical issues that are impacting the implementation of crime management strategies. Technical assistance will be provided through feedback to participants as a result of the exercise.
